Scholar Commons is a free service offered by the University Library to archive and offer access to intellectual work produced by faculty, students, and staff at Santa Clara University. Open access publications, student projects, theses, dissertations, pre-print and post-print articles, instructional resources and university archival material are all candidates for deposit.

SelectedWorks are sites that feature your research interests, CV, and publications with additional features not available on typical faculty pages. Compile your work into one place with options to upload material or link to other sites that contain your work. Control how your material is organized by customizing your headings. Track how often users have viewed your material.

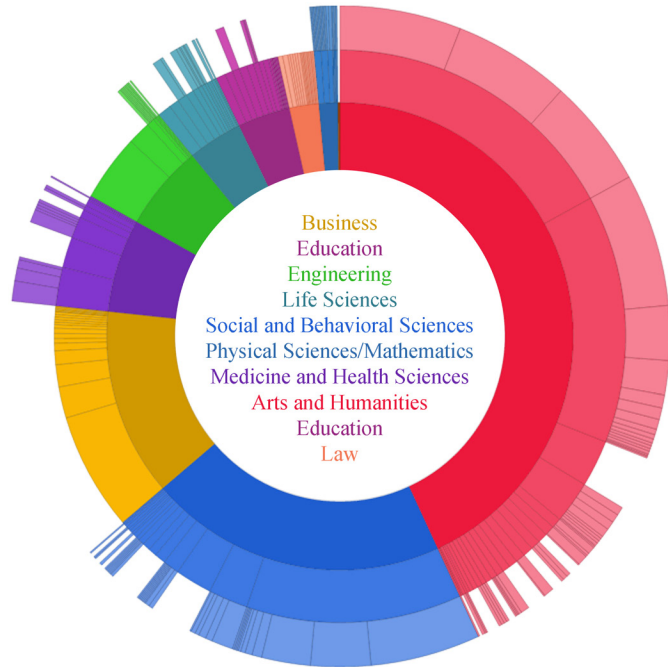
