PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Chair of the Women's and Gender Studies (WGST) Dept. reached out to the library for help creating a website featuring feminist and queer works published by SCU faculty. The goal was to showcase scholarship produced not only by WGST faculty, but also by faculty in other departments interested in gender studies.

The Library suggested using Scholar **Commons, SCU's institutional repository**, to create a special online collection. This was the beginning of a collaborative project that resulted in unforeseen benefits for all involved.






